## THE PROJECT:

Pretend your book is going to be made into a movie. Create a movie poster to promote the movie. You should read a fiction book of at least 150 pages.

## THE DETAILS:

- Use a half size poster board. (PLEASE DO NOT ROLL UP)
- Your poster should include the following elements:
  - The title of the book in large letters & the author of your book.
  - A picture of an important scene from the book, DO NOT duplicate the cover of the book. You must make an original picture.
  - Name the actors who will play the main characters from the book and explain why this actor would make a good fit for the character. At least 2 characters should be chosen.
  - Write 2 critic's comments about the movie based on your book, the critic's comments should explain how the movie is like the book and how it is not similar to the book.
  - Write a brief summary of your book. Be sure to include the theme of the book, explaining what lesson the characters learn.

## TIPS FOR SUCCESS:

- ✓ Look at movie posters, DVD/BluRay covers for ideas and inspiration.
- ✓ Plan out your poster first in pencil to make sure everything will fit.
- ✓ Use bright colors and be neat.
